**The Idaho Heritage Trust is now accepting applications for it's 2019 grant cycle.**

The Trust provides funding for 'bricks & mortar' projects to preserve historic buildings, sites, and artifact collections statewide. Grants of \$2,000 - \$10,000 are available to assist publicly owned properties that have significant historical value. The projects themselves can be essential repairs and modest preservation needs such as stabilizing foundations, replacing sill logs or a roof, re-pointing masonry or restoring windows.

"The Idaho Heritage Trust's mission is to preserve our cultural heritage across Idaho," said Judy Mortimer, Chairman of the Board. "We accomplish that through awarding and supporting groups and individuals with restoration and preservation goals. We highly encourage grant applications and seek to serve and help deserving applicants." Mortimer is from Idaho Falls.

Projects funded by the Idaho Heritage Trust must be matched dollar for dollar by the recipient. Idaho non-profit organizations as well as tribal, city, county, state, and federal agencies may apply. Grant projects funded in 2019 must be completed by November 2022.

All work funded must meet the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Buildings, or in the case of archaeological sites or collections, the applicable standards in the field. IHT provides technical assistance from a historical architect at no cost in preparation of receiving grant proposals. The technical assistance helps to assess a building's needs and provides guidance on materials and methods for restoration.

### **Buildings**
