Step 4: THE TRAIN THE TRAINER COURSE
2003**

The Train the Trainer Class will prepare participants with techniques of teaching LNT principles. The class should be at least two days and two nights (total field time of 16hrs) in a camping situation with stock and tents. The intent of this class is to provide chapters with local LNT trainers. Participant should have completed the LNT Basic skills class, unless an exception is given by a master. Below is a suggested itinerary for the Train the Trainer's Class.

- Survey campground and find appropriate place for highline.
- Instructors arrive with enough daylight to set up the wall tent and their own camps.
