The BCHI Foundation offers grants to chapters for expenditures (1) that have incurred or (2) that the chapter anticipates incurring during the year. See Appendix A for the type of expenditures that will be approved. Check the type of funding you are requesting, complete the form and send to John Millington, BCHI Foundation Treasurer, 261 Buckcamp Rd., McCall, ID 83638 or bring to the Annual Foundation Board Meeting. All requests for grants must be initiated by a Foundation Director or officer of the BCHI chapter requesting the grant.

Reimbursement Request—This is a request for the reimbursement of funds already spent for tools, materials, and/or services. Attach copy of receipt, photos if appropriate.

Request for Future Expenditure—This is a request for the anticipated spending for tools, materials, and/or services for future projects. If a grant is awarded, a receipt/s for the tool, professional service, materials, etc., for which the grant was awarded must be sent to the Foundation Treasurer before one year has elapsed from the date the grant was awarded. If the grant money, or any part of it, was not spent within a year for said purpose, the grant money or its remainder must be returned to the Foundation Treasurer.
