Salmon Challis National Forest

The Salmon Challis National Forest is in the early stage of its Forest Plan Revision. The process has been put on hold for now. The analysis is complete on the Bear creek Trail Repair in the Palisades Ranger District. This will eliminate 6 stream crossings by putting in 2 bridges and doing 4 reroutes.
